### Information request

Dear Sir,

With regard to your request, we can state the following:

- The name Krisjans Klavins is mentioned a couple of times in the Bochum investigation files. In the framework of the investigation "Flankengott" there were indications that bets were put through a middleman named Manuel Pekosek on manipulated matches. On his accounts the police have observed a payment of EURO 30'000 that was made for Krisjans Klavins. The court suggests that this is the former press officer of the LFF that was in 2005 suspected to be involved in manipulated matches.
- The investigators have monitored a chat protocol with representatives of the betting agent SAMVO that was working with Ante Sapina (convicted match-fixer) for bets on fixed matches. The two persons in the chat suggested to open a new account for someone "who wins bets". That person will pose a deposit of \$100'000 in the account. The person is identified as Krisjanis Klavins with address, phone number, etc. In the chat, they also mention that he is owner of a basketball team.
- Another report in our files suggests that money was transferred from Manuel Pekosek to Krišjānis Kļaviņš.
